Additional Rain Is Needed to Improve Crop Conditions

Recent Rains Not Sufficient to Meet Needs Permanently, United States Weather Bureau Reports.

Washington, Oct. 11.—Although the drought which prevailed for some weeks was "effectually broken" by the recent rains, the weather bureau, in a review of crop conditions, reported that insufficient rain has fallen to improve the general situation more than temporarily. The rainfall was beneficial in all sections but moisture was said to be needed generally to better conditions permanently.
