Chicago, Oct. 18.—Heavy profit-taking by longs, after all grain prices had advanced to a new high on the present upturn, proved too much for the markets readily to absorb. This resulted in a sharp reaction. The finish was well toward the bottom. Wheat closed 1 1/4@1 1/2c, corn 1 1/4@1 3/4c, oats 7 1/2@1 1/2c and rye 3 1/4@1 3/4c.

Receipts continue light and the demand for all grains is good.

Receipts of wheat were only 30 cars.

corn 42 cars, oats 23 cars ad rye and barley 4 cars. Some roads are giving preference to potato shipments which account to some extent for the light run of grain receipts. Total shipments 162 cars as compared with 153 cars a year ago.

The demand for the small offerings on the local exchange was very good and cash wheat prices were unchanged to 2 cents higher than yesterday. Corn sold 1 1/4 to 2 cents higher than yesterday's actual sales. Oats were unchanged to 4c higher, rye was nominally unchanged and barley unchanged.
