Omaha Grain. Omaha, Oct. 20. Grain prices were inclined to drag during the early session, but later in the day the news indicated that the car situation instead of getting better was still serious and was hampering the movement of corn, and the market turned strong, with the corn leading the advance.

Chicago Grain. Chicago, Oct. 20.—Liquidated by longs in December deliveries of all grains had a decidedly depressing effect on futures. At the break the sellers of December replaced that line by purchases of May. Local traders were caught short when the buying commenced and a sharp upturn came toward the late. Final trades were 1/2 cent lower on wheat, 1/4 to 3/8 cent higher on corn, 1/4 to 1/2 cent higher on oats and 1/4 to 1/2 cent lower on rye.

Live Stock. Omaha, Oct. 20. Receipts were: Cattle, 1,800 head; Hogs, 12,000; Sheep, 1,000. Market was strong for all grades of cattle.

But the larger economic interest attached to such incidents as the fall in the German mark to 90 1/2 of a cent, the rise of spot cotton to 24 1/2 cents—highest in just two years except for a single day last July—and the publication of a surprising statement of last month's merchandise import trade.
