Thomas N. Page. Ex-Ambassador. Dies Suddenly

Member of Diplomatic Service Under Wilson and Prominent Author, Expires in South.

Richmond, Va., Nev. 1 .- Thomas Nelson Page, former ambassador Italy, and widely known author, dis at the home of relatives in Hanove county, Virginia, today, according t a report received by the News Leader Mr. Page's death was sudden. The first intimation Richmond relatives had of his illness came this morning when they were called to the planta tion where the former ambasuado had gone for a rest. The only details received here was that the end cam

Although he served as American ambassador at Rome for six years. Mr. Page was best known for his fit erary productions, which had made a name for him at home and abronbefore President Wilson, at the begin ning of his administration, asked him to enter the diplomatic service He was appointed ambassador Italy in June, 1913, and served in that canneity until Auscust, 1919.

He was born April 13, 1853, in Hanover county. As a youth Mr. Page attended Washington and Lee universi ty. In 1874 the degree of bachelo of laws was conferred on him by th University of Virginia. y the honomers degree of doctor o laws was conferred on him by Wash ington and Lee. Tulane university and William and Mary college and the degree of doctor of literature by Yale, Harvard and Washington and Lee. Mr. Page was twice married-ir 1886 to Miss Anne Seddon Bruce, who

died in 1888, and to 1893 to Mrs. Plus ence Lathrop Field, widow-of Henry Field of Chicago. Her death occurred Mr. Page was author of a number

of books on southern life. Until recently Mr. Page had been making his home in Washington, but he closed his house there a few weeks ago with the intention of visiting relatives in Virginia and other states

Mr. Page's services as ambassado to Italy covered a critical period in American European relations and many of the Important diplomatic notes passing between the United States and the allied governments went through his hands.




