Double Murder Theory Looms in Christler Killing

Examination of Mrs. Carleton's Body Discloses Bullet Passed Downward-Mystery in Death Gun.

Havre, Mont., Nov. 1 -- dly A. P.J-Unexplained features of the double killing early Friday of the Rev. Leonard Jacob Christler, an outstanding churchman and orator of the state, and Mrs. Margaret Carleton, a member of his congregation, still puzzled authorities here today.

When a corner's Jury Saturday night returned a verdict to the effect that Mrs. Carleton did the shooting while under the influence of an overcose of sleeping powders, the matter appeared closed. But Mrs. Carleton's mother, Mrs. Joseph Pyle of Butte, was not satisfied, and started a further investigation.

Within the past 24 hours, it was shown that the bullet which killed Mrs. Carleton had been fixed downward, not directly in the upward, na shad been testified at the coroner's inquest. The husband of the dead woman, former District Judge Frank E. Carleton, issued in California a statement asserting that Mrs. Carleton had confessed to him her love for Rev. Mr. Christler, and had intimated Ithat her love was returned. Mr. Carleton condemned what he characterized as an "attempt to whitewash" Mr. Christier's character.

Ownership of the gun which was used in the killing is another mystery. It was not Mrs. Carleton's as far custody. ns is known. She had a revolver, a smaller weapon, which was found later among her effects. Investigation thus far has failed to disclose that it was the property of the Christ-lers. 
