Change to Atlantic or Jackson Numbers Takes Place at Midnight—New Directory Out.

All Douglas telephones will be given Atlantic or Jackson numbers at midnight tonight. A new directory showing these changes has been distributed.

changes in the telephone numbers of all central offices, due to persons moving and to new telephones being installed," said Mr. McAdams. "These changes also will be shown in the new directory. Because of the many changes in the telephone numbers, the company suggests that all subscribers look up each number after midnight tonight before making calls. "When the Omaha telephone exchange was moved from Fifteenth and Harney streets to Eighteenth and Douglas streets in 1921, there were less than 2,500 telephones in this city and less than 7,500 calls were made each day. The new directory, which will go into use tomorrow morning, shows more than 58,000 telephones in Greater Omaha, over which nearly 250,000 calls are made every 24 hours. "All the operators who have been working at the Douglas switchboard will continue in similar positions in the other Omaha telephone offices, of which there are now eight—Atlantic, Jackson, Harney, Webster, Market, Walnut, Kenwood and long distance.
