

### Corpses Thrust from Graves by Chilean Quake

#### Death Toll 548, Revised Figures Show—Valleparaiso City in Ruins—Soldiers Pull Down Walls.

Santiago, Chile, November 17.—(By A. P.)—Revised figures given out by the minister of the interior place the total of those killed in last Saturday's earthquake at 548, considerably below the earlier reports.

The entire lower section of Chanaral was razed. Seventeen are dead and many injured.

At Copiapo approximately half the houses were destroyed and others rendered uninhabitable. The dead there number 64. A hospital has been established in a motion picture theater, but only 48 patients can be accommodated at a time.

The earthquake was particularly violent in the vicinity of the Copiapo cemetery, the movement thrusting a number of corpses from their graves. Debris obstructs the canals, causing inundations, and soldiers are pulling down the tottering walls.

At Caldera, the tidal waves carried away the railroad station, work shops and custom houses and destroyed the mole. There were no casualties.

Similar damage was suffered at Curipal Bajo. The town of Curipal Alto is in ruins.

### Lake Waterway Project Involved in Subsidy Fight

#### Administration Forces Expected to Recommend Development of Waterways as Part of Ship Bill.

Washington, Nov. 17.—(Special Telegram)—The Great Lakes-St. Lawrence waterways project promises to be a large part of the ship subsidy fight which President Harding's forthcoming message to congress will inaugurate. The president is committed to the project and the supporters of the ship bill will point out the close relationship between the project and the necessity of having an American merchant marine.

### Three Die When Chicago Bootleg Nest Is Bombed

#### Wife and Baby of Owner Burned to Death—Boy Dies Following Blast in Chicago.

Chicago, Nov. 17.—Police today worked on the theory that a bomb caused last night's explosion and fire in a moonshine distillery resulting in the death of three persons and the injury of at least nine others. The explosion occurred in a mixed foreign quarter of the city, a melting pot for 11 different nationalities. Two buildings were wrecked.

### Yukon River Frozen

#### Dawson, Y. T., Nov. 17.—The Yukon river was frozen over here today for the first time this season.

In the ruins of one building, which was swept by flames, police and firemen found the wreckage of stills. The original report of the firemen, returned winter.

### No Money Panic in Mexico

#### Mexico City, Nov. 17.—(By A. P.)—The bank failures of the last few days are not significant of an economic crisis of a general character and should cause no alarm in commercial circles, according to Secretary of Finance De La Huerta.

He decries sensational reports of impending further failures, expressing the belief that business in general will proceed along normal lines.
