Improvements Expected to Make Street One of Most Traveled Thoroughfares in Omaha.



The improvements include new street car tracks from Farnam north on Sixteenth and Sherman avenue to Binney street, and new or re-surfaced paving from Dougias north to Binney.

The commissioner said similar improvements will be made on Sherman avenue next year from Binney street to the north end of the cobblestons pavenent, which is beyond Commercial avenue and north-west on Commercial avenue are line from Bayesdeanth to Sixteenth street between Cam and Clark streets. The paving and re-surfacing work is being finished now, and the work on the street car tracks is completed.
