

Federal Control of Coal Continued Until January 1

Fuel Distributor Consents to
Retain Office Until First
of Year at Request
of President.

Washington, Nov. 24.—Federal control of coal distribution must be continued until January 1, President Harding decided today. C. S. Spens, federal fuel distributor, called on the president to resign his office, but after discussing the situation, he agreed to remain in service until that date.

The president, it is understood, expects to declare the emergency during which federal control operates at an end on January 1, but considers that some degree of control must then be continued in force.

By a series of orders issued recently, the last of which came out today and released bituminous coal mine operators in the district west of the Mississippi from the necessity of reporting prices, Mr. Spens has relaxed the original regulations created to insure proper distribution of the coal supply.

In addition, the gradually increasing output of coal and the quantity of stocks in store, Mr. Spens has announced, have relieved fears of a shortage, particularly of bituminous. Anthracite, however, has presented a more serious problem in view of the prolonged shutdown, due to the strike and the impossibility of increasing output of mines.

Federal control of fuel distribution was established September 22, under

emergency legislation, and Mr. Spens was named to take charge of it, on the understanding that he would be allowed to return to his post as vice president of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy railroad on November 22, if conditions warranted.

"Brother Charley" Mum on Johnson Plum

Lincoln, Nov. 24.—(Special.)—"I have nothing to say for publication at this time."

That was the statement made today by Governor-elect Bryan in regard to the announcement that the state capital commission arranged in December, 1921, to employ George E. Johnson, state engineer, as secretary of the state capital commission at a salary of \$5,000 a year after January 1, 1923.

This announcement has made dramatic officeholders howl with anger. They claim one of the best bits of political pie at the state table has been gobbled up by Johnson.

Johnson's friends point out that he is a man appointed by Governor Morehead, democrat, reappointed by Governor Neville, democrat, and was so efficient in his work that Governor McKelvie kept him on the job throughout his tenure of office.

Purchase of Midland Plant at Sioux City Mere Rumor

Buffalo, N. Y., Nov. 24.—(Special Telegram.)—At Jacob Dold plant here officials this afternoon declared that the report of the purchase of the Midland concern of Sioux City was merely a rumor, but stated that officials are in the west looking over various possibilities.

It is believed there is little or no likelihood that the Omaha plant would be transferred to Sioux City in event the Midland plant should be purchased.

Juror Is Talkative Panel Is Disqualified

Falls City, Neb., Nov. 24.—(Special Telegram.)—Indiscretion on the part of Robert Bowman, juror, who discussed the merits of the \$10,000 suit instituted by Brice Prater against Doctors C. L. Husted and Roy W. Fouts for burns alleged to have been received in X-ray treatment, led District Judge J. B. Raper to disqualify the entire jury in the case today. Judge Raper declared this was only the second instance in his entire career of 17 years on the bench where he had to disqualify a jury on that account. The first instance occurred during the celebrated Neale case at Auburn a year ago.
