Chicago, Dec. 8.—Grain traders generally believed that President Harding's message to congress would be decidedly bullish as far as agricultural matters were concerned, and were decidedly disappointed over the abstract of the report as wired from the east. At the same time wheat showed a strong undertone with an excellent class of buying and the close was unchanged to 3-4 higher.

New York, Dec. 8.—Prices for most stocks, for many bonds and for foreign exchange, again advanced in today's market, although with some lessened momentum and occasional reaction. The stock market, indeed, gave some signs of weakness in the early hours, but recovered the lost ground and closed as a rule with respectable net advances. Wall street ascribed the recovery to the president's message to congress which it somewhat again recommended that railway systems be merged and interchange of rolling stock and terminals be made.
