


Postmaster, City of Omaha.

Your mail and your neighbor's mail is delayed if you have no mail receptacle at your door with wour name plainly written thereon. To eliminate unnecessary delay, the Postoffice Department has ruled that carrier service will not be extended to any new building not equipped with a suitable receptacle, and that when a parton changes his residence he will be required to provide a mail box at his new address before being accorded, delivery service. All patrons will be expected to have a proper mail receptacle, preferably a slot in the door, before January 1, 1923.

The faiure to provide a mail receptacle not only tends to inconvenience the patron himself, but is an unnecessary hardship on the carrier. If the carrier has to wait at a door, even if only two or three minutes, and has to do it several times in a block, it means that he has to work that much harder to complete his deliveries. If the people understood this, for the carrier's sake, if for no other reason, they would provide a box.
