### Two Fairmont Churches Unite

Merger of Presbyterian and Congregationalist Denominations Approved by Synod.

Lincoln, Dec. 19 .- (Special.)-Formal approval was given by officers of the Nebraska synod of the Presbyof its church at Fairmont with that of the Congregationalists, one of the largest experiments in a united church yet to be tried in the state.

there will be two missionary treasurers, who will get an equal division of all moneys earned for missionary purposes. The denomination entity ofar as it is related to national dies will be preserved, but the Sun day school and auxiliary societies are merged along with the congregation.

The two churches have maintained organizations in Fairmont for more than a half century. Only three Congregationalists and two Presbyterians voted against consolidation when submitted last Sunday.
