# Postal Records of Omaha Broken

### Count for Day Shows Increase of 51 Per Cent in Sacks Dispatched.

All postal records were broken Tuesday, when, by actual count, 6,428 sacks of parcels, or an increase of 51 per cent over the corresponding day a year ago, were dispatched from Omaha. Postmaster Black announced last

Less misdirected packages have been found, and parcels are almost always well wrapped and addressed, the postmaster says. He says this is to a large extent due to the publicity given important details of the postal service by the press.

New York, Dec. 20.—After an early advance which took cotton prices to slightly higher record levels for the year, today's cotton market met extensive profit taking in the second hour, which continued for the rest of the session and closed with a net loss on the day of 14 to 15 points for the near positions and 15 to 25 for the distant months. On the census bureau's ginning figures, prices were bid up early May touching 26.45c and July 28.24c, but the pre-holiday liquidation in the south, commission houses and wall street longs prices sagged and closed near the bottom.

The local market for spot cotton was quiet, 15 points decline, 26.05c for midding upland.

Southern spots: Galveston 25.80c, 15 points decline; New Orleans 26.00c; unchanged; Savannah 26.00c, 14 points decline: Memphis 26.25c; unchanged; Houston 25.75c, 10 points decline; Little Rock 25.75c, unchanged.


