

Widow of Phone Inventor Dies in Washington

Mrs. Alexander Graham Bell Succumbs After Long Illness at Home of Daughter.

Washington, Jan. 4.—Mrs. Alexander Graham Bell, 63, widow of the famous inventor, died here last night after a long illness.

Mrs. Bell died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. David Fairchild, where she had been falling ever since the death last August of the famous inventor.

Mrs. Bell was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Gardner Greene Hubbard of Cambridge, Mass., where she was born in 1859.

She married Alexander Graham Bell in Boston in 1874, after she had studied at his school of voice culture.

Mrs. Bell is survived by two daughters, Elsie May Grosvenor, wife of Dr. Gilbert Grosvenor, president of the National Geographic society, and Marian Hubbard Fairchild, wife of Dr. David Fairchild, United States Department of Agriculture, and by Grace Hubbard Bell, her sister, wife of Charles I. Bell, president of the American Security and Trust company of this city.
