

Officials Admit Probe of Russian Jewels Mystery

Won't Open Grave of Seaman However, Unless Evidence Gathered Warrants Such Action.

New York, Jan. 5.—Government officials today frankly admitted they were investigating reports that Russian crown jewels to the value of \$4,000,000 had been smuggled into this country in the coffin of an American sailor and buried in the National cemetery in Brooklyn.

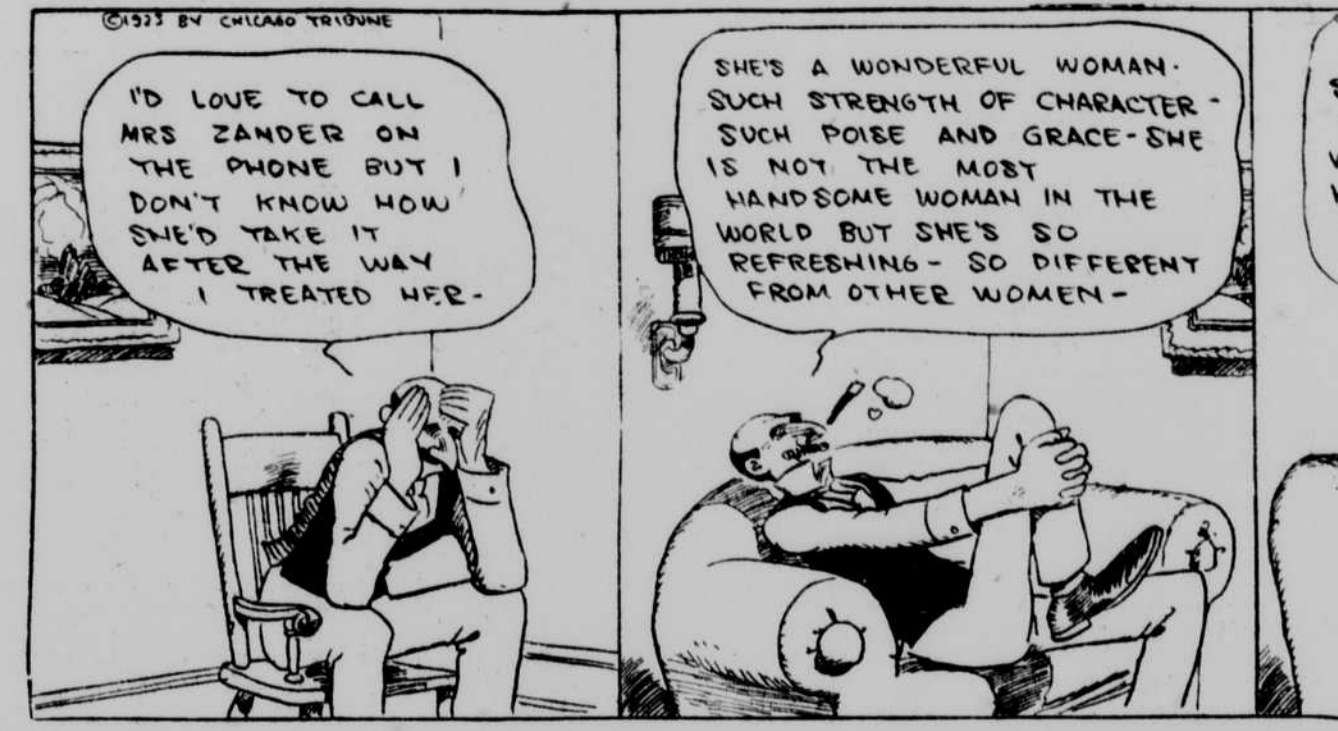
William E. Williams, special agent of the treasury department, who previously admitted he was working on a Russian jewel case, preserved strict silence today until Assistant Secretary Clifford in Washington had issued an official statement, announcing that an investigation had been ordered.

Meanwhile the grave of Seaman James Jones, who died on the army transport Edlyn at Gibraltar in August, 1920, on the way to the United States from Vladivostok and into whose coffin the jewels were reported to have been slipped, remained undisturbed under its mantle of snow.
