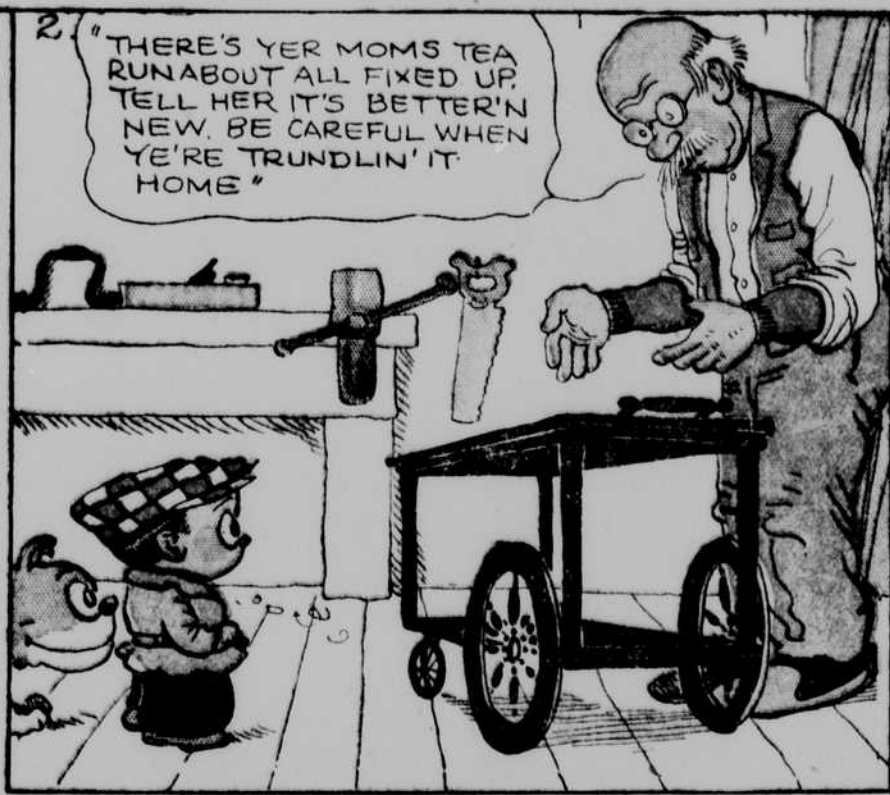




Little Jimmy

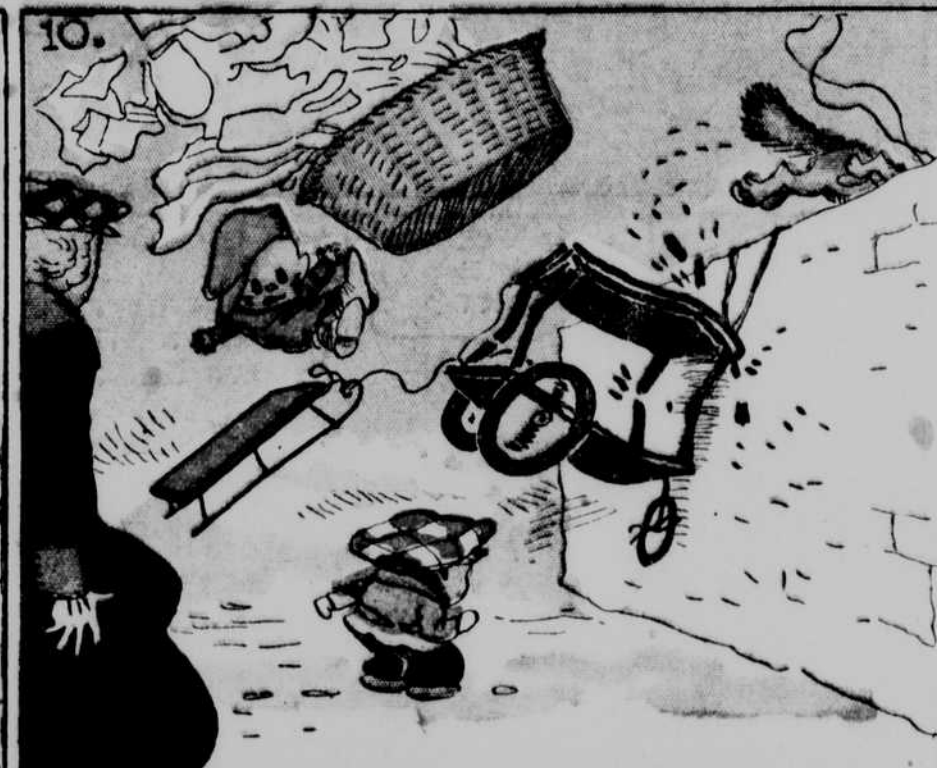
