Anti-La Follette Fight Seen in **Senate Move**

Naming of Lenroot as Assistant Leader Forecast of Administration Attitude in Next Election.

Washington, Feb. 10 .- (Special.)-Administration approval is assumed to have been given to the change in the senate leadership announced last Saturday by which Senator Wads worth of New York and Senator Lenroot of Wisconsin become assistant leaders under the generalship of Senator Lodge. Although a young man, and one of the ablest men in the senate, Wadsworth is regarded as a conservative. He is a regular republican-not hidebound-but committed to the ideas of party regularity and of accepted republican doctrines.

Lenroot, another one of the young er senate leaders, is a progressive in spots, but far removed from the degree of progressivism represented by his colleague, Senator La Follette. The selection of Lenroot for senate leadership is a direct challenge to the La Follette group. The feud on between Lenroot and La Follette is one which admits of no quarter and Len-


