Rails Not "Blown Up."

Although some notes of caution have been struck in the market letters of brokerage houses, following the recent advance in security prices, there has been little if any fear of a reaction expressed as likely in the case of most of the representative railroad stocks. According to the reasoning advanced, the rails have as a group moved more slowly than the industrial as they have not been shown up. to the extent of some of the more spectacular filers in other groups, in addition will have for their support the appearance of more January earnings reports which, it is judged on the basis of already known January cars loading statements, will show a continuation of the upward movement in both gross and net earnings.
