Fish Scarce on Omaha Market

Pineapples from West Indies Among Latest Arrivals on Fruit Market.

Pineapples from the West Indies are among the latest arrivals on the local fruit market. The lemon market is firm. There is an apparent shortage of small size oranges. Strawberries are arriving in very

good shape from Florida, and the demand is equal to the supply. Green peas, cauliflower, and head lettuce from California; carrots, turnips and beets from Louisiana; egg plant and green beans from Kansas and hot house cukes from Florida are plentiful on this market, and the quality is very good. French endive, mushrooms and artichokes show especial popularity on the Omaha market.

Haddock fillet steak arrived on the Omaha fish market this week. This fish comes from Boston, is packed in individual containers, ready for use, and can be prepared in many palatable ways, among which are broiling, frying and toasting. Fresh trout from the Green Bay

district are being received in limited quantities. The same is true of pike. Both these varieties are high in price, owing to their scarcity. There is a small quantity of fresh halibut here at this time. Chesapeake oysters are practically off of the Omaha market. On account of the harbors being frozen, prices have soared to a point which
