Rail Executive **Urges Four-Line** Consolidation

Hale Holden Would Merge All Roads West of Chicago Into Four Great

Systems.

Washington, March 1,-(A)-A plan for consolidation of all the railroads west of Chicago into four great systems, each operating over 30,000 miles of line, was laid before the Interstate Commerce commission today by Hale Holden, president of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy.

The object of the vast consolidation he proposed, which would go far beyond present government consolidation plans, would be the creation of four such systems which would each reach from Chicago to the Pacific coast and from the gulf to the Canadian border.

The Burlington, Great Northern, Northern Pacific, Kansas City Southern, Chicago Great Western, Louisiana Railway and Navigation company, Trinity & Brazos Valley and subsidlary corporations would be in one Thomas, 2019 Binney street.

A second group would be made up of the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe; Chicago & Northwestern, Duluth, Missabe & Northern; Duluth & Iron Minneapolis, St. Paul & Saulte Ste. Marie; Chicago & Eastern Illinois, St. Louis Southwestern, Duluth, Winnipeg & Pacific; Western Pacific and a series of smaller lines.

Third Group.

In the third group would be placed Island & Pacific, Missouri Pacific, burial will take place. 
