

Court Bars Tots From Movie Show Circuit in Omaha

Six Juveniles Who Performed in Theaters in Competition for Prizes Adjudged Delinquent.

Judge L. B. Day, in juvenile court Saturday morning adjudged six children—the oldest 11—delinquent because they performed in theaters in competition for prizes.

Each was paroled on the promises of parents to prevent repetitions of the offenses.

Judge Day declared he hoped to

help break up a "child circuit of neighborhood vaudeville stages."

John Yeager, deputy county attorney, scanned that section of the child labor law under which prosecution took place, but declined to give a "hair line" interpretation.

"Whether the law would apply to recitals would have to be decided by a court," he said. "The law specifies 'concert hall.' It is possible, of course, that even a dwelling in which art or music students gathered to give a recital to which admission was charged would be held to be a concert hall."

Trials of Louts and Sam Epstein, theater owners, South Omaha, and Dorothy De Vere, head of a dance school, charged with aiding and abetting the delinquency of minors by staging juvenile acts, probably will be held before Judge Day in district court this week.

An attorney representing them was barred by Judge Day from taking

part in the hearings of the children in juvenile court.

"While there was no monetary consideration," Judge Day said after he had heard the children, "a prize was offered. It is understood that children are being taken from theater to theater, night after night, to compete for the prizes. A 'neighborhood circuit' has been formed and innocent children are being ground through the mill, reports show."

A spectator testified one boy was found crying off stage and begging not to be made to go on because of a sore throat.

The children found delinquent were Lucile Harsh, 11, 3222 Himebaugh avenue; Jane Strong, 9, 5218 North Thirty-eighth street; Thomas Bennett, 8, 808 South Twenty-fourth street; Katherine Fitzgerald, 10, 603 South Twenty-seventh street; Hallie Malone, 9, 2605 North Nineteenth street; Marjorie Peterson, 8, 3312 North Twenty-eighth avenue. Dorothy and Blaine

Wahl, 7 and 13, respectively, 102 Chalmers apartment, also charged, did not appear and Judge Day ordered them to be arrested and taken to Riverview home.

The Magic and Rialto theaters were involved in the charges.

Harding Appoints New U. S. Ambassador to Japan
