

"Safety First." Policy of New Credit Banks

Regulations for Government Institutions Completed—To Start With \$1,000,000 Capital Each.

Washington, March 12.—The federal farm loan board, charged with administration of the new government financed intermediate credit banks, completed today the regulations which are to serve as the guide for the system's operation. Indications were given following a conference between Commissioner Lobdell of the board and Secretary Mellon, that a million dollars will be turned over to each of the 12 banks immediately upon the issuing of charters. Additional funds, up to the aggregate of \$60,000,000, will be supplied as needs arise.
