

### Supply of Eggs Abundant Here

### Frosts in South Cut Down Tomato and Strawberry Shipments.

Omaha enters the Easter period with an abundant supply of eggs on the market.

California strawberry rhubarb arrived on the market Wednesday. Tomatoes and strawberries have been more or less of a disappointment for the Easter trade, due to recent frosts in the south.

However, there is plenty of prime fresh green vegetables on the market to take care of the seasonal trade. Cauliflower, head lettuce, radishes, onions, endive and asparagus are popular sellers. New potatoes at \$7.50 a bushel are finding a ready sale.

Large size oranges of unexcelled quality are in abundant supply and dropped a bit in price last week.

Wineapples and Arkansas Blackies are included among the fruit offerings.

Shad roe made its appearance on

local counters with the advent of the Lenten season.

Lobster is scarce and extremely high. Fish reached its highest point of popularity during the week as a result of Lent and the beginning of the Jewish passover.

Smoked fish of choice quality has gained popularity for the same reason. Fresh Canadian fish has been received steadily, and a good supply of oysters is available.

### Inquiry Into Marriage With 15-Year-Old Girl

Irvin Stalmaster, deputy county attorney, is investigating the marriage of Charles E. Day, 45, and Frances Chalkov, 15, daughter of Max Chalkov of Sioux City, Ia.

They were married March 25 at Fort Smith, Ark.

Day has a son, Tom, 17, to whom he introduced his new bride as his "new mother."

A former wife, Cecilia Rithler, whom Day married when she was 14, is now in the state school for girls, the marriage having been annulled.

In view of the fact that the marriage took place in Arkansas, Mr. Stalmaster says that Douglas county

authorities have no authority to act unless investigation reveals illegal conduct prior to marriage, in which case federal statutes might be invoked against Day.
