

Chinese Envoy on Way to Tell U.S. About Shooting

Dr. Sze Will Explain Circumstances Surrounding Murder of American Citizen at Kalgan Gate.

Washington, April 8.—With a little black bag, Dr. Alfred Sze, Chinese minister to the United States, is speeding across the Pacific ocean to tell Secretary of State Hughes the facts about the recent shooting of Charles Colman, American citizen, at the Kalgan gate of the Great Wall of China.

In the bag are his voluminous instructions, and in addition, data by which he will seek to enlighten the secretary on internal affairs in the land of the poppies.

Colman was killed last December while endeavoring to pass through the Kalgan gate with silver to buy merchandise. Anticipating some difficulty and wishing to be of aid, American Consul Schmitt accompanied him, narrowly missed hitting the American official.

Note (Virtually Ultimatum). Secretary Hughes sent off a stiff note of protest which was regarded as practically an ultimatum. The Chinese government formally apologized to the United States government, that the family of Colman be properly indemnified, that the military governor of the Chahar tribe of the Great Wall apologize to the officials who were responsible for the death and be removed from office and that if found guilty, be punished by it.

These governments have been in power in China since Colman was killed. China is reported to be searching with the spirit of revolt, its factions engaged in bush warfare and its civilian population torn with conflicting sentiments and emotions. Just who is in authority, it is hard to say, but Dr. Sze will attempt to persuade Secretary Hughes that his faction still holds the reins at Pekin, in north China, and that it will make suitable amends. However, there is some question as to whether all the demands will be met in full.

Demand Change Be Tried. Colman lived in the city before he died. On the meantime Jacob G. Schurman, minister to China, filed strong protests with the Pekin government. An effort was made to execute a few Chinese coolies to shield the higher-up in the case, Chang Hsien-chang, who is alleged to have ordered the men to fire. This arrangement proved unsatisfactory and the American government demands that Chang be tried.

A verdict of guilty would cause him to be shot. The American note also carried a strong plea that citizens of this country be given ample protection while pursuing their trades. For some quarters the idea has gained prevalence that China has availed a straightforward policy to have ordered satisfaction. It is also claimed that travelers who will take risks in foreign countries, are liable to meet with emergencies.

Man Mistaken for Robber is Shot. Watchmen Fires on H. E. Wells in Tech High Construction Office.

H. E. Wells, 2109-12 Cuming street, labor foreman at Technical High school, was shot and seriously wounded when he was mistaken for a burglar by Steve Bouras, 1312 Douglas street, night watchman at the high school. Wells, in company with Frank Elshire, also employed at the building, had gone to the place to get a bottle of whiskey. It was said, "An other shot was fired through his left thumb and the third shot went wild. Bouras and Elshire, who were on duty, were being held for investigation. Wells was removed to the Lord Lister hospital after he had had his wounds dressed by Dr. Kinyoun, police surgeon, at the station. He is expected to recover.
