

**Stevens Is Re-Elected
A.O.U.W. Grand Master**

Grand Island, Neb., May 9.—The Grand lodge of the A. O. U. W. elected John Stevens of Beaver City grand master for the fourth time. H. R. Rousey, Grand Island, was elected recorder; W. T. Gould, Elm Creek,

member of the finance committee; S. E. Sinke, Grand Island, treasurer; E. Breuklander, Valentine, grand foreman, and Oliver D. Hedge, Red Cloud, watchman. Grand Island was chosen on the first ballot for the next biennial convention.
