

Nebraska Dental Society to Open Convention Here
500 Dentists Will Attend Four-Day Meeting—Prominent Speakers on Program.

Five hundred Nebraska dentists will be in Omaha Monday to attend the annual convention of the Nebraska Dental Society. Activities will be divided between Hotel Fontenelle and the Auditorium. Executive council and other meetings are to be held at the Fontenelle, while lectures, meetings and exhibits of dental supply houses are to be at the Auditorium. The convention will bring to Omaha several men of international prominence in the dental world, as well as men who are well known in the profession in the middle west. Monday morning will be devoted exclusively to the annual golf tournament of the Nebraska Dentists' Golf Association. Monday noon there will be a meeting and luncheon of the executive council. The convention will be opened formally at 1:30 at the Fontenelle, Mayor James Dahlman delivering the address of welcome. Dr. J. H. Wallace, Omaha, will preside.

Dr. Johnson to Speak.
Dr. C. N. Johnson, Chicago, one of the best known dental teachers in the world, will speak on "Dental Economics." Dr. Otto U. King, Chicago, member of the American Dental Association, will lecture on "The Dentist Who Wins."

Monday night there will be a testimonial banquet at the Fontenelle at which Dr. Johnson will be the guest of honor. Several dentists will appear on the toast program, which will be complimentary to the career of Dr. Johnson. A token, expressing the esteem with which he is held in the dental profession, will be presented to him during the banquet.

School Health Discussion.
A demonstration and discussion of what is being done in Omaha schools to promote health education will be held. This will be under the supervision of Miss Charlotte Townsend, supervisor of school nurses. The remainder of the evening will be spent in dancing.

Tuesday lectures are to be delivered by Dr. Willis A. Coston, Topeka, and Dr. L. L. Furnas, Cleveland. Their lectures will be opened to the convention for discussion, led by selected dentists. Tuesday afternoon demonstrations will be conducted at the Auditorium.

Throughout the four days the convention is in session there will be a series of clinics and demonstrations covering every phase of dentistry.

Committee Plans Flag Day Show
Council of Americanization to Receive New Citizens at Auditorium.

The Omaha Council of Americanization decided at a meeting held Friday afternoon to put on a show for three days, beginning Flag Day, June 14. June 12 to 13 will be observed as "Flag Day" week. On Tuesday night, June 12, at a mass meeting in the Auditorium, a class of new citizens will be received. Gen. George E. Duncan will be the speaker.

Details of the three-day show have not been decided. Mayor Dahlman, who is president of the Omaha Council of Americanization, endorsed the proposal to hold the show. This organization has classes in various parts of the city, for men and women, and for various nationalities. English and citizenship are taught. The work of the council has been approved by the federal government, the board of education, the retailers' association, the jobbers' association, and other organizations, according to S. R. Elson, secretary.
