

French May Use Motor Hearses Old-Time Slow Procession to Be Replaced by Modern Auto Busses.

Omaha, May 26.—Picturiques and decorative French funeral processions are expected to disappear, martyrs to modernism, if the suggestions of M. Ritor, a member of the Paris club, are adopted by French speakers and the French public.

As the procession passes along the streets of the city, passers-by stop for an instant in their walk, the men tipping their hats, the women making the sign of the cross.

Ritor argues it is illogical that the old style procession should exist in this modern age, that it clogs the thoroughfare, disturbs business, and works a hardship on the mourners, who often walk many miles behind the hearses in unfavorable weather.

There has been a moderate business in grain in the United Kingdom recently. Offerings of American sorts are rather limited but good quantities of Plate corn are being offered.
