

Grand Island Mayor Dies at Home

Dispatch to The Omaha Bee. Grand Island, Neb., May 26.—Mayor Schuff, former mayor of the city and senior member of the firm Schuff and Sons, owners of the Grand Island and the Schuff Cafeteria, died here. Henry Schuff, jr., a junior in the University of Pennsylvania, arrived home an hour before his father died and was urged by him to complete his studies and was advised that education is of first importance.

Mr. Schuff entered business in Grand Island in 1894 as restaurateur, later buying the Palmer house and also building the present Schuff Cafeteria and rooming house in another section of the business district. His sons Lester and Fred are associated with him in the management of the two properties. He was elected mayor in 1905 and was twice elected, his administration being featured by the inauguration of paving in the city and the establishment of municipal lighting plant.

His wife and three sons survive him.

Reclamation Project Viewed by Officials

Special Dispatch to The Omaha Bee. Scottsbluffs, May 26.—Assistant Secretary of the Interior Davis, Director A. P. Davis of the reclamation service and Agricultural Commissioner Miles Canoon, today completed a two day tour of inspection of the North Platte valley reclamation project, in which the high spots were two mass meetings, when the farmers of the district told what they expected of the government in the way of aid. Extension of time on payments for the water charges was asked by most of the farmers, who gave the depression of the past year as the reason for asking this. No one suggested a cancellation of the charges.

Piloted by James T. Whitehead, president of the North Platte Valley Water Users association, and Bert Seger, the secretary, the reclamation officials toured west from Bridgeport then turned south on the way east again to view the work on the Gering-Fort Laramie unit now under construction. At Nine Mile community and at

Scottsbluff, mass meetings were held, at which both farmers and reclamation officials talked.
