Calcutta, June 9 .- Dr. Hugh Mc-Govern, the Irish Buddhist priest who ently succeeded in penetrating the world's greatest rampart of mountains, the Himalayas, behind which lies the forbidden city of Lhassa. has just retudned to Darpeering after having been arrested by British frontier authorities for violating Tib et's sacred ground. The doctor re orts that in his attempts to get into Lhassa he and his four compan ions suffered intense privations and xposure in the snowclad mountains which are 500 feet higher than the highest peaks in the United States. After battling with snowstorms day and night and being compelled more

than once to retrace his steps, Mc Govern at Hangu was confronted with strike of his servants, who refused to go further. He kept his ultimate destination secret from his npanions, fearing they would reert him if they knew the distance and the hardships. On the desolate mountain pass of Karula the Irish elate revealed his objective. Only inder compulsion did his companions

ntinue the journey with him. To avoid detection by the franatical Tibetans Dr. McGovern dyed his hair and painted his whole body so as to look like a native. Thus disquised and attired in the dress of a peasant. he played the role of coolie and cook After many weeks of trying experi ences and reverses he finally reached Lhassa, only to be apprehended by the Tibetans, who ordered his imediate deportation. He is now with riends in Darjeeling and will soon eave for England.
