

New Building for Nebraska Buick

Plans for the construction of a new \$300,000 building adjacent to its present building were announced last night by the Nebraska Buick Auto

company. The company is located at Nineteenth and Howard streets and the new structure will be east south of the present building and will be connected with it by archways.

The new site was purchased through H. A. Tukey from A. J. Love for \$30,000, Lee Huff, vice president of the company, said. The building will be a duplicate of the old structure, four stories, rein-

forced concrete, 126 by 100 feet. Construction will begin at once and is expected to be completed in eight months.

Los Angeles to Have 1924 Live Stock Convention

Buffalo, N. Y., June 16.—Los Angeles won the 1924 convention of the National Livestock exchange at the closing session of the convention here

today. President Everett C. Brown of Chicago and other officers were re-elected with the exception of vice presidents, who are elected by the local exchanges. The Los Angeles exchange was admitted to the national organization during the present convention.

The convention approved a resolution upholding the principle of competitive buying of livestock.

10-Cent Tram Fare Goes Into Effect in Seattle

Seattle, Wash., June 16.—Under an emergency ordinance fare of 10 cents cash or three rides for a quarter, went into effect today on the Seattle municipal street car system, the same rates in vogue when a reduction to 5 cents became effective March 1. Officials estimated that the receipts

would increase about \$4,500 a day, as against a deficit of \$3,000 to \$4,000 a day with the 5 cent fare, and that it would take 18 months to get the system back to a cash basis.

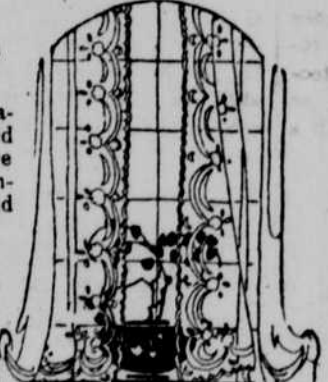

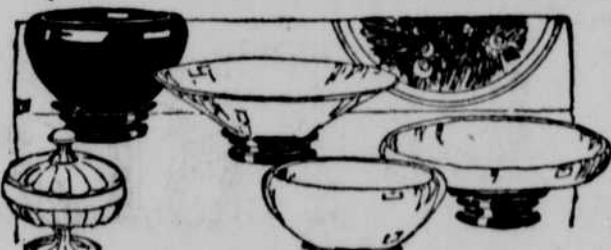
