

### French War Hero Answers Critics of His Country

#### Gen. Henri Gouraud Declares People Who Call France Militaristic Nation Are "Stupid Liars."

Washington, July 7.—"Those who call France militaristic are stupid liars," Gen. Henri Joseph Eugene Gouraud, one of France's greatest military leaders, declared today in a speech to the citizens of Camp Meade, Md. He said: "America has no military frontiers and no threat lies at her borders, yet the young men of the United States are preparing themselves to leap to the defense of their country at the call of their president. France, who must guard her frontiers against treacherous foes or risk her existence as a nation, is called militaristic because she keeps a standing army which serves for a year and a half."

#### Inspects Training Camp

Despite the fact that his day was filled with engagements of an official nature, beginning with luncheon with the mayor of Baltimore in that city and ending with General Persh's dinner, General Gouraud found time to inspect the citizens training camp at Camp Meade and review the 5,000 men there.

"Wonderful! Marvelous! Magnificent! Astonishing!" were some of the exclamations elicited as the students marched in review before one of Europe's best judges of military material.

"And you say to me that some of these men have had but 11 days of training?" he inquired of Gen. Harold B. Fliske, commanding officer at the camp. "It would be unbelievable but for what I have seen raw American recruits do in France."

### Artificial Respiration Proves a Great Lifesaver

#### Victims of Drowning, Electric Shock and Violent Blows Are Revived, Captain Fisher's Book Shows.

"A man may live without breathing!" This amazing statement was made by Capt. G. R. G. Fisher of the American Red Cross. And he has proved it.



Not long ago in a nearby state a boy of 11 was drowned and his body was not recovered for 20 minutes. Two doctors carefully examined it and declared there was no hope of restoring life. They covered the body and notified the coroner. As soon as the doctors were out of sight, a Boy Scout companion of the lad snatched off the sheet and began to perform artificial respiration, and within 45 minutes the boy was revived.

#### Omaha Western Center of Dog-Breeding World

Industry in Omaha Alone Reaches Value of \$150,000—Thousands of Prize Winners in Big Shows Sired in Kennels of State Every Year—Bring Fancy Prices.

Omaha is the western center of pedigree dog breeding of the United States. A survey made by the Bureau of Publicity of the Chamber of Commerce reveals some interesting information.

There are about 140 members of the Nebraska Kennel club, an organization whose purpose is the promotion of pedigree dog breeding, scientific care of the dogs and the mutual interests of dog lovers in general. About 70 members live in Omaha. They average five dogs each, whose valuation, on the average, is \$150 each, a total of \$10,500.

While dog breeding has progressed in the past few years, owing to the growing popularity of certain breeds, there are no breeders in Omaha who follow that line exclusively, as many are professional business or laboring men. One breeder operates a poultry farm in connection with his dog breeding, consequently the money invested in plant for dog breeding is comparatively low, being estimated at \$15,000.

#### Health Is Guarded.

Kennels in every instance are clean, well ventilated and healthful. The health of the dogs is guarded as closely as the health of humans. Their food is selected scientifically and their ill are doctored with skill.

Dogs are shipped to him from all points of the country and they go to school to him just as youngsters do when they are shipped off to college by their parents. When the schooling is finished the dogs are returned to their owners.
