Score for Boston in eighth inning: Boston 4, Detroit 2.

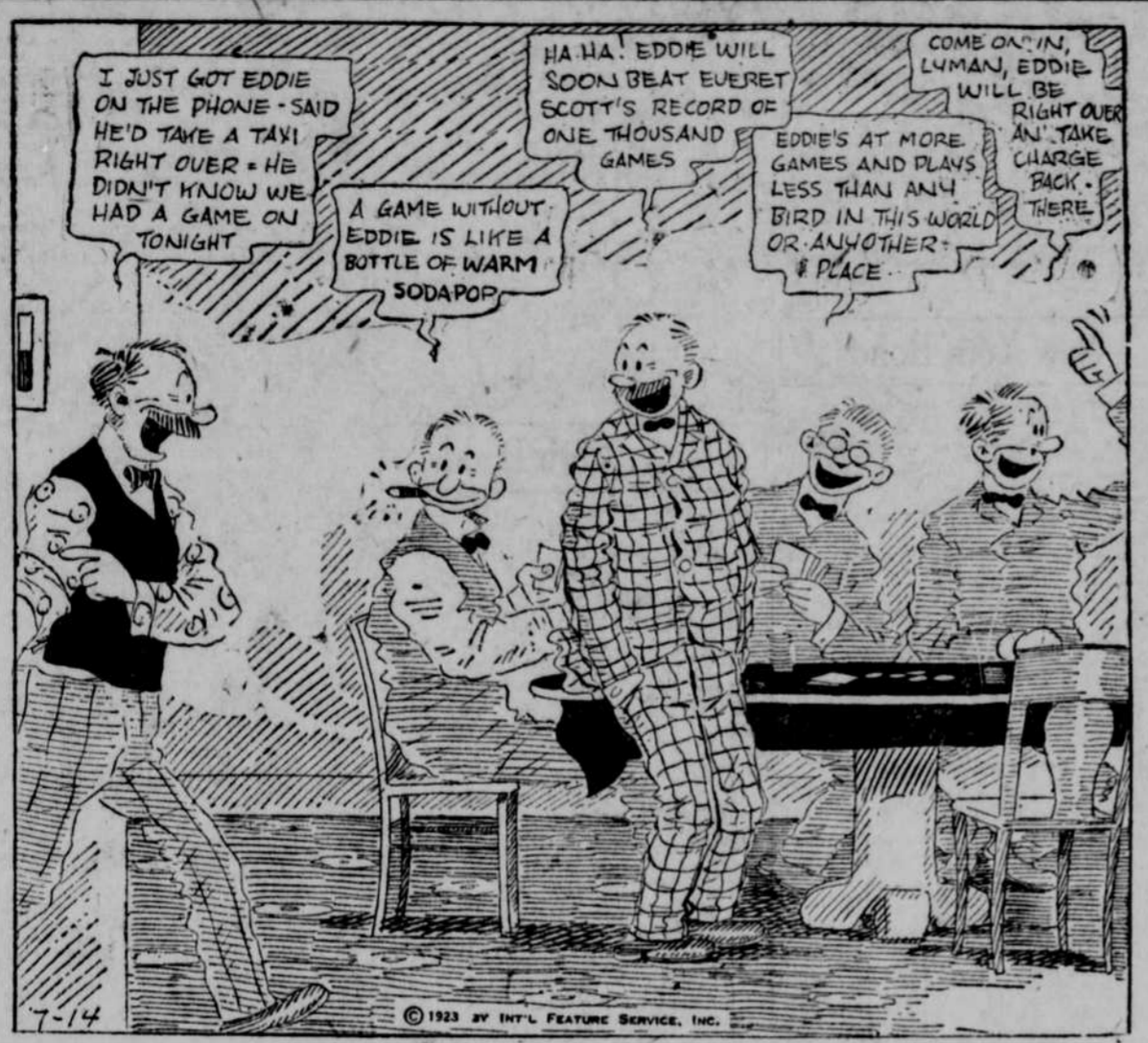
Havana Wants Dempsey-Firpo
