Douglas County, Nebraska, thence South one hundred and fifteen (113) feet, thence northwesterly one Eundred and eighty (180) feet more or less to a point on the South Line of Military Avenue, one hundred and forty-one feet West of 52d Street, thence East one hundred and forty-one flat of beginning in the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby declared part of the system of public parks, parkways and boulevards and to be known as Koutsky Cutoff and to be improved as may be hereafter ordered and required.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after fifteen days after its passage.
