El Paso, Tex., Aug. 27.-With two rises in the Rio Grande due late today, forecast by the United States reclamation so lice, several hundred more persons today were fleeing from their homes near the lowlands of Juarez, where 1,200 were driven out

JULY WHOLESALE PRICES DECLINE

Vashington, Aug. 27 .- Further re

duction in production of basic commodities and of employment in indus trial establishments was reflected during July by a decline in wholesale prices, the federal reserve board said today in a review of business conditions. Distribution of goods as indicated by ralroad freight reports maintained a high level and retail sale though showing seasonal declines, "continued to be relatively heavy."

According to the board's index production fell off 1 per cent in July, mill consumption of cotton, steel ingot output and sugar meltings being considerably small than in June. New building operations also showed more than a normal seasonal loss, while employment decreased about 2 per cent.


