

Peanut Suit Dismissed.
Norfolk, Va., Sept. 25.—The \$3,625,000 damage suit of the Peanut Growers' association against 15 cleaning and shelling concerns were dismissed

by Judge Groner in the United States district court under agreement by counsel for both sides. The agreement reached through a series of conferences held since the adjournment

of court Friday carried with it, it is understood, the payment of \$30,000 to the plaintiff.
