

Ethics, Ideals of Newspaper Told

The editorial page is the proper and only place for a newspaper to express its views, according to B. Brewer, general manager of The Omaha Bee, who addressed the Omaha Business Women's club at a dinner in the Y. W. C. A. auditorium Tuesday night. He said that the paper ceases to be interesting when the news columns are tainted by a spirit of partisanship. Mr. Brewer discussed human inter-

est as a vital factor and spoke of the unfairness of interpreting the facts in a news story to fit the writer's opinions. Mr. Brewer explained that advertising is an important factor in putting out a newspaper, since the paper alone which is used in a copy costs as much as or perhaps more than

the price which the finished product brings on the street. The club visited The Omaha Bee plant, where they were shown the various sections in operation. The Business Women's club is conducting a membership drive at present, under the leadership of Mrs. Maude Adair. The organization in-

cludes 196 members, of whom 110 were in attendance at the dinner. Miss Florence L. Hathaway is president, Miss Pearl Jenks, vice president, Miss Emma Worm, secretary, and Mrs. Doris B. Gray, publicity manager.

Heavy Quake Registered.

Washington, Oct. 10.—Earth tremors of pronounced intensity were recorded early today on the seismograph at the Coast and Geodetic Survey observatory. Beginning at 2:30 a. m. the tremors reached a maximum intensity about 29 minutes later and

continued until 3:48 a. m. Director Tondorf of the observatory estimated the center of the disturbance to be 3,500 miles distant from Washington, apparently in a southerly direction.

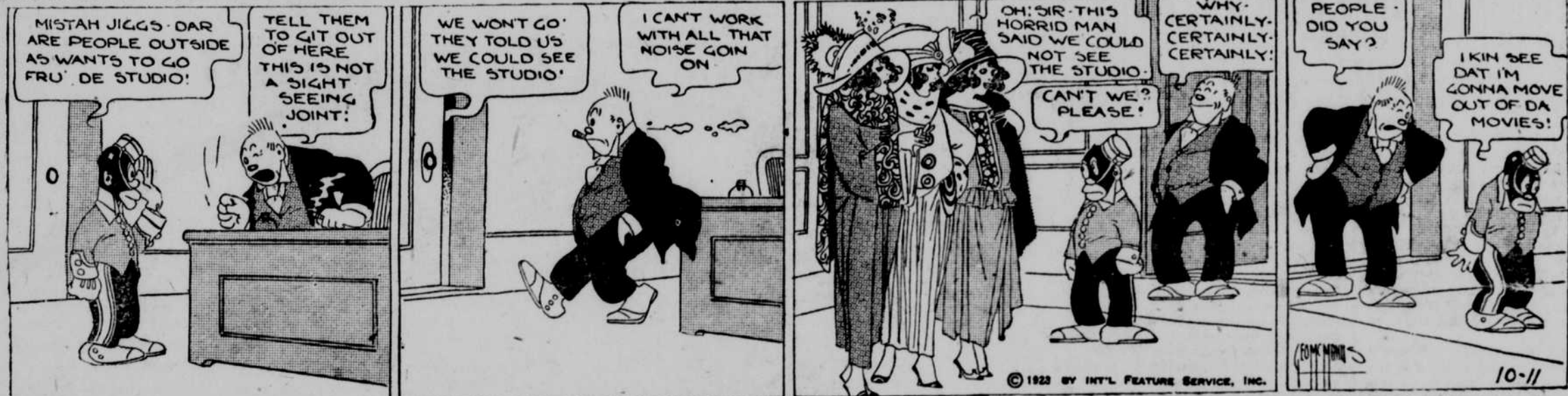

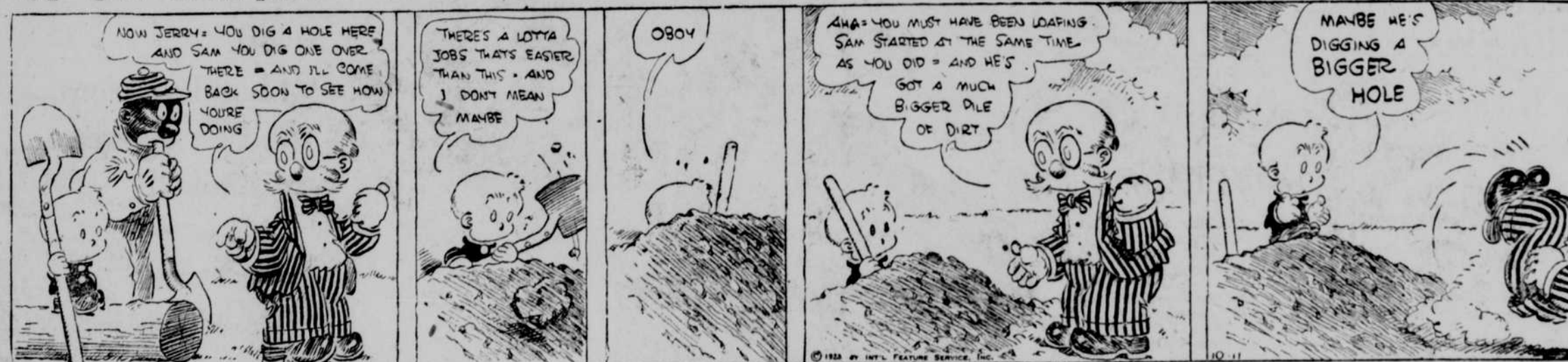
