

**Consistory No. 1  
to Hold Reunion  
Here This Week**

Candidates From All Parts of  
Iowa, Nebraska, South Dakota  
and Kansas to  
Take Degrees.

The stage is set, the curtain is drawn, all is in readiness for the 66th reunion of consistory No. 1, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite, tomorrow. For four days this week the candidates for advancement in Masonry will be initiated in the mysteries, rites and lights of the consistory.

From all parts of Nebraska, Iowa, South Dakota, Kansas and many other states come the candidates and those who have passed through as candidates, to become 32d degree Masons. The class of novices is expected to number 150 and arrangements have been made to accommodate from 1,500 to 2,000 visitors and consistory No. 1, A. A. S. R. members.

**Recess for Meals.**  
With all the pomp, solemnity and grandeur of the days of knights and squires, the first day of the reunion will open with initiation into the mysteries of the Lodge of Perfection, with John William Cooper, 32d degree, K. C. C. H., venerable master, presiding. As on each day to come, the ceremonies will cease at noon for lunch, at evening for dinner and, after dinner, will soon terminate for the night.

Tuesday, the second day, the class of candidates will be passed through the Semper Fidelis chapter, Knights of the Rose Croix. Amadeus Andrews Holtman, 32d degree, wise master, will direct the destinies of the class on that day.

**Pass to 30th Degree.**  
Theodore Wilson McCullough, 32d degree, eminent commander, will enlighten the candidates on Wednesday, the third day of the reunion. From 9 in the morning until 7:30 in the evening, the class will pass from degree to degree until the 30th is reached.

Thursday will be marked by the conferring of the first rites of the consistory. James Robert Cain, Jr., 32d degree, venerable master of Kadash, will guide proceedings. Each section of the rites and mysteries will be passed and the day and the reunion will end that night with the traditional consistory banquet.

The class will continue its travels across the burning sands of the desert toward its goal, the Shrine.
