

### Careless Potato Grading Blamed for Weak Market

Omaha Commission Men Refute Charges of Discrimination Made by Dawes County Farmers.

More careful grading of potatoes by Nebraska potato growers will open up and help to establish one of the strongest markets in the west for the sale of Nebraska grown potatoes, according to Omaha commission men who were interviewed yesterday by J. M. Gillan, manager of the industrial committee of the Omaha Chamber of Commerce.

Practically every Omaha dealer refuted charges alleged to have been made some time ago by Dawes county farmers that from 85 to 90 per cent of potatoes consumed in Omaha were grown outside of Nebraska. Some of the dealers complained that Nebraska potatoes were not graded as carefully as Minnesota potatoes, but in cases where they were, they would rather handle the home grown product than those from other states. But in spite of this fact, they had handled large quantities of Nebraska grown potatoes.

Robert Trimble of Trimble Bros., said that his company was glad to handle Nebraska potatoes and could have handled larger volumes had the Nebraska growers been willing to take what they were worth on the market. He said growers had been shipping direct to consumers in Omaha from Crawford, Neb., and they had demanded \$1.15 a hundred-weight and the commission men declared that competition from adjacent states was too strong to permit holding the market to that figure.

R. M. Tyson, B. Blotcky and J. M. Bouda, all spoke highly of Nebraska grown potatoes. Mr. Blotcky declared that from 60 to 75 per cent of all potatoes he handled this season were home grown. The J. Robinson

Fruit company and J. M. Bouda made the same estimate of the potatoes handled by their firms. R. M. Tyson declared that had Nebraska growers graded their product more carefully, they could have competed more favorably with potato growers of Minnesota and North Dakota, because of the necessity of longer shipments to the Omaha market. In spite of the longer shipment, he declared the foreign grown potatoes were more reasonable in price than the home product.

The agricultural bureau of the Chamber of Commerce is endeavoring to call immediate attention to Nebraska growers, urging them to lay in their winter supply of potatoes now and to purchase Nebraska grown potatoes by the bushel rather than by the peck.

### Jacob Dold Sued for \$181,000 by Brother

Buffalo, N. Y., Nov. 23.—Suit for \$181,801.75 and costs has been begun before Justice Hinkley in supreme court by Victor B. Dold against his brother, Jacob C. Dold, president of the J. C. Dold Packing company, 22 Middlesex road.

This is one of a series of actions which have been brought against Jacob C. Dold by relatives. Settlement was made with a sister, Miss Eva Dold, and a verdict of \$35,000 was won by another sister, Mrs. Clara Brunke. Negotiations are still pending in a case brought last fall by a nephew, George F. Dold.

The plaintiff alleges that Mr. Dold bought up the stock held by his brothers and sisters in the J. C. Dold Packing company at a price below its value, by misrepresenting to them the financial condition of the company. Shortly after the stock had been acquired, according to the plaintiff's allegations, the company gave evidence of being in a flourishing financial condition with the stock worth much more than Mr. Dold had paid for it.

**New Rail Power Plant Completed at Wymore**  
Wymore, Neb., Nov. 23.—The Burlington railway today practically completed a new heat and power plant which has been under construction at their shop yards here for the last 60 days. The plant represents an expenditure of several thousand dollars and is located just north of the roundhouse and engineer's room.
