Thomas H. MacDonald chief of the bureau of public roads in his annual report made public today, announced that 26,536 miles of federal aid highways have been com pleted, of which 8,820 were finished within the last fiscal year. In ad dition, 14.,772 mfles were under con struction June 30, while 6,917 more were contemplated in projects that had been approved.

As certified by the various states, the total mileage of rural roads in the country is 2,859,575 miles which will limit the federal aid system to 200,170 miles. Approved federal aid roads in 35 states show that 1.048 of the 1,111 cities of 5,000 or more population in those states will be touched by at least one of the routes.




