

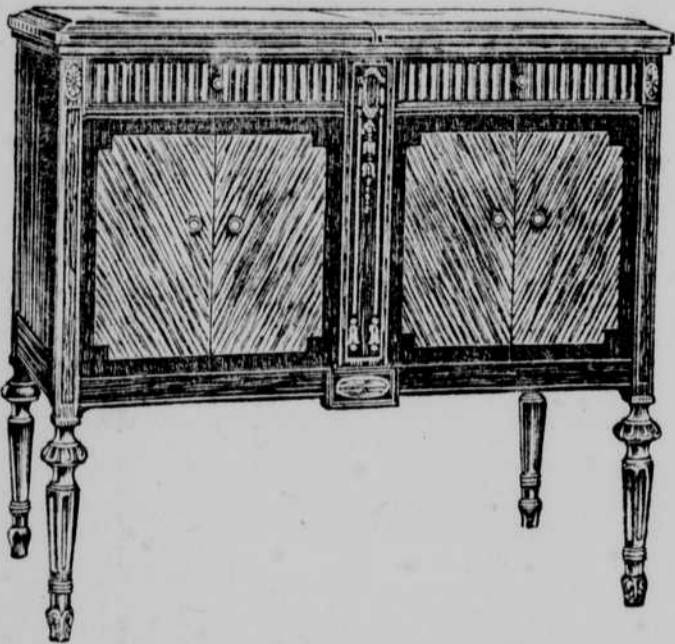
**Santa Remembers
