

Market Bodies Do Big Business

Washington, Jan. 7.—Marketing organizations of farmers did more than \$2,000,000 worth of business last year.

Reports to the Department of Agriculture from 2,600 grain organizations show business totaling \$490,000, 600; 1,841 dairy products organizations, \$300,000; 1,182 livestock shipping associations, \$220,000; 938 fruit and vegetable associations, \$280,000; 78 cotton cooperatives, \$100,000; and 14 tobacco organizations, \$132,000.

Only 8,313 of the 10,300 organizations have reported, of which 90 per cent were primarily engaged in selling farm products and 10 per cent in collective purchasing of farm supplies.

Grain Exports Slump. Washington, Jan. 7.—Grain last week amounted to 1,320,000 bushels compared with 1,568,000 bushels the week before.

Figures made public by the Commerce department today gave the following comparisons between exports last week and those of the previous week:

Corn, 496,000 bushels against 2,550,000 bushels; oats, 44,000 against 83,000; wheat, 79,000 against 1,528,000.

Canadian grain exported from United States ports amounted to 3,469,000 bushels compared with 3,341,000 the previous week.

3 Grades of Crude Oil Up. Pittsburgh, Jan. 7.—Fifteen cents a barrel was added to the price of three grades of crude oil today, the new prices being:
