The author said that the legend of the "Elders of the Zion" the story of the aspiration of the Jews o seek control of the world, had long igo been exposed as a forgery, but that the story still continued and he characterized Mr. Ford as "dishonest"

in his attacks upon the Jews.' Referring to the Ku Klux Klan ngwill said that the organization has the impudence" to hold itself ut as 100 per cent American while being intolerent of the Jew, the Catholie and the negro.
