BERLIN PRISONERS BUILDING PRISONS

Berlin, March 6.—Convicts in Germany have lately been employed in erecting their own prisons. Monasteries and nunneries are being reconstructed for use as prisons. Penitentiaries throughout Germany are overcrowded. Hundreds of convicts have to wait for weeks and months to serve their terms. That is partly due to the post-war crime wave flooding central Europe, and partly to the fact that several big prisons have been seized by the French in the occupied territories.

At present there are about 65,000 convicts confined in Prussian prisons as against the average pre-war rate of 50,000. Though about 120 prisons are available in Prussia, former working houses and public buildings have to be rebuilt in order to be repurposed for penitentiaries.

The result of this calamity is that courts resort to fines instead of prison terms in minor offenses. Hundreds of convicts sentenced to short terms are granted a virtually indefinite release. As a result criminality is increasing at an alarming rate.
