#### Nebraska Auto **EDDIE'S FRIENDS** Drivers Escape

Motorists Pay Less Than in Other States, Property Owners Pay More.

ndent The Omaha Bee Washington, March 17.-Statistics compiled by the United States Department of Agriculture show clearly that Nebraska motorists do not pay as much for good roads as motorists in other states, and the burden of good road building is much heavier on the shoulders of property owners in Nebraska than in most other states.

This is clearly contradictory to the doctrine of Nebraska's governor, Charles W. Bryan, who during his last campaign proposed to cut auto license taxes one-half. He attempted to put such a bill through the last legislature.

Government statistics show that the total revenue from registration fees, licenses and permits in Ne braska sizes up fairly even with similar sources of automobile revenue in other states. However, the same statistical report shows that while Nebraska turned down a gasoline tax proposed by a former governor at a special session two years ago, other states are adopting it rapidly. At the present time there are 35 states which have a gasoline tax used to augment payment for road work by the road users, the automobilists.

Revenue Will Increase.

"In 35 states a gasoline tax ranging from 1 to 4 cents per gallon is imposed" the departmental report "Revenue from this source, amounting to \$36,300,000, is spent very largely for highway, purposes. This revenue will be materially increased in 1924 since in many states such taxes have been in effect only a few months."

The report further shows the few states besides Nebraska which, as Debate Stirred Up in Senate yet, have not adopted a gasoline tax as a means of producing good road They are: District of Columbia, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mis-Rhode Island and Wisconsin.
