

Speculative Trade Tackling on Chicago Grain Market

Apathetic Interest of Buyers Especially Noted in Wheat Pit

Sharp Upturn at Liverpool and Decrease in Visible Supply Ignored.

Chicago, April 14.—Grains traded through an afternoon session today with little activity. Especially was the apathetic interest of the speculative portfolio in the wheat pit, this grain entirely ignoring the sharp upturn at Liverpool, and a decrease of nearly 2,000,000 bushels in the United States visible supply for the week.

Wheat closed unchanged to 1/32 lower; corn was 3/8 to 1/32 down; oats were unchanged to 1/32 lower, and rye and rye 1/32 higher to 1/4 lower.

Receipts Very Light

French Government and Muny Loans Rally to Highest Levels of Year

Rise Due to Prospects for Acceptance of Dawes Report; Home Lien Trade Dull.

New York, April 14.—Contrasting sharply with general depression of bond prices in today's trading, French government and muny loans rallied to the highest levels of the year on improved prospects for acceptance by Germany of the Dawes report. The advance was accompanied in the face of dulling trade in domestic line, which was featured by a sharp break in Wilson and company issues.
