PROPERTY TAX, TRADE READS SAYS

Delay in Anti-Trust Prosecution Charged Before Senate Committee.

Washington, April 22.—Chairman Houston Thompson of the Federal Trade Commission today laid before the Daugherty investigating committee further evidence to support his testimony that anti-trust cases were not properly prosecuted under Attorney General Daugherty after facts warranting legal action had been developed by the commission and turned over to the justice department.

Turning from companies in the tobacco industry, which he described at length yesterday, the commission chairman related how he and his colleagues uncovered "price fixing" and "coercive measures" among lumber producers in an investigation beginning in 1933. The results of this inquiry, he said, were laid before the justice department before Mr. Daugherty took office. Suit against the Southern Pine association was instituted in the closing days of the Wilson administration, he declared, but "has remained in status quo ever since and now rests in the district court at Kansas City.

The Southern Pine association, Mr. Thompson explained, included most of the large manufacturers of that commodity. "The investigation, as we reported it to the Department of Justice," he said, "showed price fixing and price regulation and production restriction by different groups of the Southern Pine association and coercive measures towards various concerns to make them work in co-operation with the association."

John H. Kirby of Texas, Mr. Thompson said, had been head of the Southern Pine association. Senator Wheeler read into the record a speech made by Mr. Kirby in New Orleans last month, vigorously defending Attorney General Daugherty and Secretary Fall.

"No criminal prosecution of any kind has ever been brought" Senator Wheeler asked. "No, sir."

All together, the witness declared there was abundant evidence of a general "conspiracy" among lumber associations, resulting in high prices and "very considerable profits to the lumber manufacturers."
