IOWAN MAY GET TRADE BOARD JOB

Charles W. Hunt Recommended to Coolidge by Senator Cummins.

Washington, April 23.—Charles W. Hunt of Des Moines, secretary of the Iowa Farm Bureau federation, was recommended to President Coolidge today by Senator Cummins, republican, Iowa, for appointment to the vacancy on the federal trade commission.

Des Moines, April 23.—Should Charles W. Hunt be appointed to the vacancy on the federal trade commission as recommended to President Coolidge by Senator Cummins, he will be the second officer of the Iowa Farm Bureau federation to be honored by federal appointment during the year.

Several months ago Mr. Hunt succeeded Edward H. Cunningham as secretary of the Iowa farm bureau when the latter was appointed a member of the federal reserve board. Mr. Hunt previously had been president of the farm bureau and had been active in its organization for many years. He owns a stock farm at Logan, Ia.

TWENTY-ONE DIE IN TRAIN WRECK

Bodies Charred by Flames Following Head-on Collision.

Geneva, April 23.—Twenty-one persons were reported burned to death in the collision of two passenger trains filled with tourists near Bellinzona, Canton of Ticino, today. Scores were injured. First reports from the scene said it was unknown if there were any Americans on the trains.

One train was from Milan and Gothard, filled with German tourists, returning to Germany from Italy. The other train was from Lucerne, carrying tourists to Italy.

Following the crash the wreckage caught fire and one coach was burned.

Relief trains were rushed to the scene and doctors treated the injured in the open.

M'ADOO STATE MANAGER DIES

Chattanooga, Tenn., April 23.—George Fort Milton, 55, owner and editor of the Chattanooga Evening News, and one of the best known men in business and politics in Tennessee, died suddenly early today in the Jordan hotel in Murfreesboro, Tenn., according to a long distance telephone message to the Times. Death was due to heart disease.

Mr. Milton was state manager for William Gibbs McAdoo in his presidential campaign.

Oil Promoter Guilty.

Texarkana, Ark., April 23.—Pat Marr, oil field promoter, was found guilty in federal district court here today on one count and not guilty on 19 other counts of an indictment charging misuse of the mails.

W. T. Earhart, W. S. Eakins and George White, co-defendants with Marr, were found not guilty on all of the counts in the indictment.

Ranaway Victim Unchanged.

Mrs. Etta McGuire, who was seriously injured in a runaway accident is reported to be holding her own at Lord Lister hospital. Mrs. McGuire filed a \$25,000 damage suit against the dealers that sold her the horses.
