

Boy Jury Finds for Defendant

Guest of Mortarist Hurt in Crash Loses Many Court Suits.

The case of Max Schmidt against M. Lake in Judge Frank M. Dineen's division of municipal court was decided Tuesday afternoon in favor of the defendant by a jury of boys completing the following: Clark Walsh, 2228 South Thirty-third street; William Dugdale, 4022 Seward street; Frances Hess, 4198 North Twenty-seventh street; Frances McGuire, 3807 Cass street; Hawthorne Ave., 3019 Underwood avenue; and Hubert McCoy, 2409 Chicago street.

Sitting with Judge Dineen as associates were two juvenile judges, Harold Brick, 2124 LaSalle street and Louis Grubbill, 2124 North Sixteenth street. The jury was out only 10 minutes in its deliberations. The case was one wherein the plaintiff alleged that on December 26, 1922, at the special request and invitation of the defendant, he went for an automobile ride, intending to go from Thirty-eighth and Grant streets to Seventeenth and Cuming streets, and that at Thirty-fourth and Grant streets, while the defendant was trying to negotiate a turn, the car turned over and plaintiff suffered various injuries.

The youthful jurors held that the plaintiff did not establish a measure of damages, that the two front teeth alleged to have been knocked out were teeth that had been worn down and were not worth much in the open market.

Platte County Teachers to Gather at Columbus

Columbus, Neb., April 29.—Platte County Superintendent Fred S. Leeson has arranged for a meeting of teachers to be held in the Columbus High school Saturday afternoon next. I. N. Clark, director of rural education in the state superintendent's office, is coming from Lincoln. He will answer whatever questions the county teachers wish to ask. Nebraska laws give the state superintendent of public instruction power to regulate the course of study used in the rural schools of the state. Acting on his rights, the state superintendent has compiled a new course of study to replace the present course, which has been in effect for the past 15 years. The new curriculum is to be placed in effect with the beginning of the new school years next September.

Plans for Sunday School Convention Discussed

Nebraska City, Neb., April 29.—Representatives of Nebraska City churches and a committee of workers for the state Sunday school convention, to be held here in May, held a conference at the Presbyterian church to perfect plans. Fifty years ago the State Sunday School association met in Nebraska City and the centennial year is to be observed at a semi-centennial convention. It is expected at least 1,000 delegates will attend this convention.
