

Omaha Makes Sweep of Wichita Series, Winning Final Contest 6 to 3

Trio of Homers by Buffaloes Features Game

Joe Dalley Returns to Lineup, Pitching Good Brand of Ball for Eight Innings.

The Buffalo Buffaloes routed the Wichita Indians out of an early victory yesterday afternoon when they capped the long end of a 6 to 3 score in the third and final game of the series, scoring a total of 19 runs to the victor's nine in the three contests.

Home runs played a big part in the Buffaloes' win yesterday. The herd scored two runs in the third when Thompson got his second home run of the series, and in the seventh "Red" Wilder knocked the ball over the center field fence with Bonowitz at base, registering two more. In the eighth Bonowitz got his second homer off a Wichita hurler and boosted Griggs across the plate when he slammed the ball over the right field fence.

In the three games which Wichita the Buffaloes have clinched out six home runs to the two credited to the Buffaloes. The four-baggers played important parts in the first and third games and the chances are that if the Buffaloes had not socked the ball out of the park on these various occasions the herd might not have made a clean sweep of the series.

Joe Dalley, Buffalo castoff in 1932, returned to the mound for the local club and for eight innings hurled as nice a brand of baseball as one would expect to see in this league. Joe got in trouble three or four times, but he straightened up and pulled out of each and every tight quarter until the eighth when he weakened and had to be relieved by Bill Bailey. The latter sailed along on an even keel and Omaha won.

Bailey allowed the Wichites ten hits in the seven and one-third innings he pitched and it wasn't until the eighth that he was scored on. Of course, the other Buffaloes gave him good support and that helped Joe a great deal.

In the eighth Joe walked Smith and Butler in succession. Dunning got a single, scoring Smith and Beck followed with a one-bagger that sent Butler across the rubber. Dalley was through for the afternoon and when he went to the dugout the fans gave him a good hand. Bailey took up the hurling duties and Crandell, hitting for Walker, nipped him for a single that scored Dunning with the third run. Haley lined one down to Thompson who threw to O'Neill at second. The latter then whipped the ball down to Griggs at first and this double play ruined Wichita's chances for any more scores. The Buffaloes retired the side in one, two, three order in the ninth. Numbered among the victims was Garcia who went in to pinch hit for Hovlik.

Hovlik was on the hill for the Wichites and was bounced for nine hits, three of them being home runs. The Buffaloes scored two in the third when Wilder walked and Thompson knocked the ball over the right field fence. The home boys took the lead right then and there. In the seventh Bonowitz singled to center and after being boosted to second on Wilcox's sacrifice, scored when Wilder knocked the ball over the center field fence. The last two Omaha scorers lobbed up in the eighth when Griggs singled to center field and Bonowitz came through with a home run over the right field fence. The Wichites outbit the Buffaloes during the three games, collecting something like 29 hits to the herd's 21, but the trouble with the visitors was that they were unable to hit at
