Young Mother of Three Small Children Found Dead in Bed.

Mrs. Irma Wiseman Uren, 54, wife of Dr. Claude T. Uren, physician, 303 South Fifth street, was found dead in bed Saturday morning when Dr. Uren awakened at 7. Dr. Ralph Lockart, the family physician, was called and death was pronounced due to acute dilation of the heart. Mrs. Uren had not complained of ill health on Friday.

She was born in Omaha in April, 1869 and had lived here all her life. She is survived by her husband, three small children, Jane, 8, Claude Thomas, Jr., 4, and Marjorie Ann, 2, her mother, Mrs. Anna K. Wiseman, who made her home with her daughter, and a brother, Fred, who is in the navy.

Funeral services will be held Monday, 7:30 p. m., at the home, Rev. Thomas Casady, pastor of All Saints church, will officiate. Burial will be in Forest Lawn cemetery.
